The back nine started with a halve both girls making good pars going down the narrow tenth. Chloe then managed to take both of the next 2 holes with par and a birdie coming up the twelfth.

Honor matched Chloe on the difficult par 4 thirteenth but Chloe secured victory on the fourteenth green with another par enough to take the match winning by 5 and 4
