- All cards should be returned to the registration desk at the end of the game. Ensure they are signed.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions players will be advised on the appropriate action to be taken.
- The bar and kitchen will be open from 0800.
- Practice Rounds. Should you wish to play a practice round prior to the event, please contact the Pro shop: **£18**
- It is anticipated that course marshals and ball spotters will be on the course throughout the event.
- Defibrillator on site.
- There is not a toilet on the course.
- **Food jacket potato with cheese or beans.**
